The daughter looked at her and asked, "Do you really believe that?" Jane responded, "I have nothing without it."

Jane is not the only one who has nothing without the Resurrection. Paul told the church in Corinth this absolute, sober truth: "if we have hoped in Christ for this life only, we are of all men most to be pitied." (1 Cor. 15:19)

Most of our culture spends its time as if they will be here forever. We collect things as if they were eternal. We store stuff as if we will always have it. Not so.

"But now Christ has been raised!" (1 Cor. 15:20) This triumphant shout ends Paul's sad speculation about a world devoid of the hope of the Resurrection. The most credible eyewitnesses in history assure us that the same Jesus who rested in the tomb came out alive and well and continues to live.

The Resurrection is all that we have. You've never seen a hearse pulling a U-Haul. When asked after a funeral, "How much did he leave?," the pastor replied: "all of it".
