See the difference? "A wonderful musician" vs. "a wonderful person." Why did I find that so interesting? Because by that one little word, Mister Rogers has given us a window into his heart and told us what he values most about a person: character over talent. Most, on the other hand, are quick to value talent over character. It is refreshing to confirm that character matters.
