**Brandon's Blurp:**

Worship comes from the Anglican word *weorðscipe* (worship). This word means to ordain or formally recognize something or someone as *of worth*. The postfix 'ship' denotes the condition of being for the prefix 'worth'. The Lord *is* worthy by His very nature. Our response to His kind grace is to ascribe worth to Him and serve Him through any biblical measures afforded to us. One means of proclaiming His worth is music. Music can be an incredible tool for worship or, sadly, an unfortunate detractor. Music must always be the utensil, not the recipient. We should worship the Lord with music. But we are not to idolize or worship music itself lest we elevate the creation while forsaking the Creator.
