Dr. Roy Fish is a legend at Southwestern Seminary in Ft. Worth. Dr. Fish, Distinguished Professor of Evangelism who recently passed away, was famous for his elaborate object lessons in class. One of his most storied (infamous even?) lessons occurred several years ago and has made the rounds as a sermon illustration all over the country.

One day his Personal Evangelism class arrived to find a large target attached to a wall in the classroom. At each desk was a dart, a piece of paper and a crayon. Dr. Fish told the class to draw a picture of someone they disliked or someone who had made them angry or hurt their feelings- and he would allow them to throw darts at that person's picture.

One student drew a picture of a woman who had stolen her boyfriend. Another drew a picture of his younger brother. One student even drew a picture of Dr. Fish (no report on what kind of grade she made in the class)!

The class lined up and began throwing darts amidst much laughter. Some of the students threw with such force they ripped apart the targets.

After a few moments, Dr. Fish began removing the targets from the wall. One by one they came off, revealing underneath a picture of Jesus. A hush fell over the room as each student viewed the mangled image of their Savior. Holes and jagged marks covered his face.

Dr. Fish said only these words, "Inasmuch as you have done it to the least of these my brothers, you have done it unto me." Matthew 25:40

Is God in favor of this brand of population control? I think you know the Church's position on abortion, but more importantly, do you know
