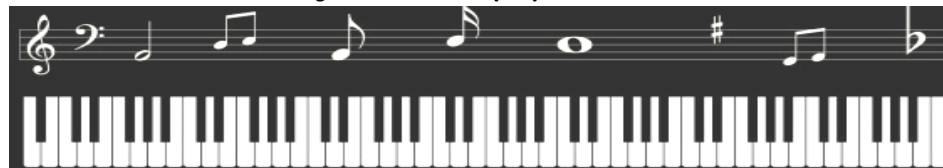

Bro. K says: "Obed Who?"

"And the Lord blessed the house of Obed-edom, and all that he had." 1 Chronicles 13:14

Tucked away in an Old Testament story is this statement. A couple of questions you might have right off the bat:

1. Who in the world is Obed-edom, and
2. Why was he blessed by the Lord?

Obed-edom was a Philistine. Yeah, "those" Philistines. The people who were a constant nemesis for Israel; the people who hated God; the people who brought you Goliath. Those people. So it's not surprising Brother Obed doesn't get a lot of play in Scripture. But there was something very different about Obed than his Philistine compatriots. He loved the Lord. He was loyal to David and Israel.

If we ask about the basis of his blessing, we find it explained simply as the fact that Obed-edom had opened his home to the Ark of the Covenant of Jehovah. That Ark, of course, was a symbol and sign of God's presence with His people. Indeed, it was more: in the Tabernacle (and later in the Temple) it was the throne of the Lord. And Obed-edom opened his house for the throne of Jehovah. No wonder God blessed him!

Why do we need to be reminded about this very minor figure in the dark, dusty corners of the Old Testament, nearly 3000 years later?

Because what God did for Obed-edom, He desperately wants to do for you. He's waiting for you to open your home to Him.
