The 11 teams in the Big-10 have now become the 14 teams in the Big-10, taking one of the teams from the Big-12, and 2 from the Pac 12. The 8 remaining teams in the Big-12 then lost another team to make 13 teams in the Pac-10. The 7 teams in the Big-12 have now found 4 teams from the MAC, while the 14 teams in the Big-10 may want one more team from the Big-12, giving the Big-10 13 teams, and the Big-12, 10. The Pac-10 would like to take 4 more teams from the Big-12, making 15 teams in the Pac-10, 13 teams in the Big-10, and 5 teams in the Big-12, but wait, the Big 12 is adding more, giving them anywhere between 9 and 13 teams. Oh, and the SEC takes 2 more from the Big 12. The MAC will more than likely dissolve, adding an additional 8 teams to the mix. The ACC will add the MAC leftovers giving them 20 teams. This will give the ACC 4 divisions of 5 teams, or 2 divisions of 10 teams. Got it?

Those were Jesus' words in John 3 when a confused and discouraged Nicodemus came to Him, seeking answers to questions he had long struggled with, but found no help .
